

This Card Deck will provide an overview of COTA//Plus — an on-demand microtransit service that offers rides from point A to point B in designated zones.




COTA//Plus offers solutions to neighborhoods with mobility needs. COTA currently has three designated zones in Grove City, Westerville and the South Side.










South Side

South Side Zone: Seven Days a Week, 5:30 a.m.-8 p.m.

Connects to COTA Lines: 1 (Kenny/ Livingston), 4 (Indianola/Lockbourne), 5 (W. 5th/Refugee), 8 (Karl/S High/ Parsons), 11 (Bryden/Maize) and 22 (OSU/Rickenbacker).

Includes service to: German Village, the Brewery District, Nationwide Children's Hospital, Reeb Avenue Center, The Marion Franklin Community Recreation Center and more!



To schedule your trip in the app:

1. Select the number and type of passengers (adult, student, senior, etc.).

2. Enter your pickup and drop-off within the eligible COTA//Plus zone. The app will alert you if the location isn't eligible.

3. Add optional driver notes on the "Details" page (e.g., pickup instructions).


4. Review and tap "Next" to confirm your trip.











Once you've scheduled and confirmed your trip using the COTA//Plus app, you can view your vehicle's location, estimated pickup time, the Operator's name and license number and receive real-time updates through the app and optional text messages. If you're scheduling by phone, you can request text message updates for your pickup.
