A Park and Ride is a large parking lot with a nearby bus stop where you can park your car for free and catch a COTA bus. It's a convenient way to get to destinations across Central Ohio, including work, school and fun spots in Downtown Columbus.











COTA has many Park and Ride locations throughout Central Ohio, making it easy to travel to and from downtown and beyond. To find route maps and stop locations, visit COTA.com/how-to-ride and scroll to the bottom of the page for Park and Ride information.



Using Park and Rides comes with a lot of benefits! You can safely park your car at a Park and Ride location for free and take the bus instead. When more people ride the bus, there are fewer cars on the road. This means less traffic and reduced pollution.











You don't have to pay for expensive parking in busy areas like downtown or the Short North, and you can save money on gas.



You don't have to worry about getting stuck in traffic or finding a parking spot. You can just park at one of the Park and Rides, hop on the bus and relax!











When you use a Park and Ride, arrive before the scheduled departure time. Drive in, park in any available space and look for the marked COTA bus stop sign.
